K. Riva Levinson (Heresy Press)

At twenty-four, Levinson was the only woman in the room at **Black, Manafort, Stone & Kelly**, the 1980s lobbying shop that operated as a kind of privatised State Department. Her memoir runs from Washington back channels to **Jamba, Mogadishu**, and **Kashmir**, hustling for clients few would touch — **Savimbi's UNITA among them** — and reckoning, decades later, with what that cost her.
